## Your Home Emergency Supply Kit

---

- Three (3) day supply of non-perishable food
- Three (3) day supply of water (one gallon per person per day)
- Manual can opener
- Tools, including crescent wrench
- Crowbar
- Matches or fire starter
- Potassium Iodine (water purification) tablets or chlorine
- Portable AM/FM radio (preferably hand cranked or solar rechargeable) with batteries
- Flashlight with batteries
- Extra batteries (alkaline are best)
- Fire extinguisher (ABC type)
- Large Plastic garbage bags
- First-aid kit and manual
- Personal hygiene items
- Toilet paper
- Pen and paper
- Duct tape
- Whistle Clothing (extra for warm and cool weather, rain gear, sturdy shoes, gloves)
- Blankets
- Sleeping bags
- Cash and coins (ATM's may be inoperable)
- Fireproof box for documents
- Important documents (ID's, credit cards, insurance info, deeds, marriage/birth certificates, proof of residency, etc.)
- Photographs of family members
- Special needs items (prescriptions, eye glasses, contact lens solution, hearing aid batteries, etc.)
- Important phone numbers (out of town contacts, doctors, hospital, etc.)
- Infant needs
- Pet Supplies

- Seasonal supplies (blankets, poncho, tools, etc.)
